Russ Stanton, an 11-year veteran of the *Los Angeles Times*, is the newspaper's 14th editor. Prior to his appointment as editor, he was named the newspaper's first innovation editor in 2007. In that position, he oversaw the online news report and started to integrate The Times' print newsroom with its Web operation.

Jacob Weisberg is chairman and editor-in-chief of the Slate Group. Before joining Slate, Weisberg wrote about politics for magazines, including the *New Republic, Newsweek, Vanity Fair, and the New York Times Magazine. His most recent book, The Bush Tragedy, was a New York Times* best seller. in 2008.
